Greetings from Kapaa Shores, on Kauai, one of the Hawaiian islands. Known as the Garden Island, Kauai is home to hundreds of exotic flowers and beautiful beaches. Spend your days scuba diving or hiking and your nights at WorldMark Kapaa Shores.

**WorldMark has 49 units at this shared resort consisting of one and two bedroom units with fully equipped kitchens and private lanais. None of the units at this resort have air-conditioning** but do have ceiling fans and, most times of the year, a steady tradewind is present. **The two bedroom units have their own washers and dryers while complimentary laundry facilities are available onsite for other units.** Common area bbqs are available next to the pool. ResortNet, WorldMark's hi-speed internet service, is available in all units for a small fee.

The resort amenities include an unheated pool, a spa, and a tennis court. Although the resort is on the beach the area in front of the resort is **not suitable for swimming. However, there are a number of beach options within an easy walk or drive away. Please be sure to look for the Kapaa Shore sign located at the front of the property as there are no WorldMark-specific signs present.**

# Things to See and Do at Kapaa Shore

Often referred to as the “Island of Discovery,” Kauai is the perfect place for a truly relaxing and peaceful Hawaiian getaway. WorldMark at Kapaa Shore offers endless recreation possibilities and unforgettable experiences.

Located oceanfront on the east coast, Kapaa Shore is complete with nearby white sandy beaches, lush jungle-like gardens and quiet island simplicity. Rain, wind and powerful wave action have sculpted the coast into a series of steep cliffs that drop off to the ocean, with lush valleys worn between them.

While in Kauai, take full advantage of the many activities at your fingertips in these exotic surroundings. Make plans for an outdoor adventure with a hike along the **Na Pali Cliffs**, or take a cruise down the **Wailua River** to the famous **Fern Grotto**. Or drive to **Hanalei Bay**, **Poipu Beach** and **Waimea Canyon**.

To learn more about Kauai’s rich culture and history, visit the **Kauai Museum** in Lihue. Its rotating displays of photos and artifacts provide insight into the island’s natural and social history. The **Grove Farm Homestead Museum** is home to one of Kauai’s largest plantations. Touring this gracious home and garden teaches you how the birth of the sugar industry has changed Kauai. You can even taste raw coffee beans and macadamia nuts fresh from the harvest.

The **Kilauea Lighthouse** was built in 1913 and at one point housed the largest lens of its kind in the world. No longer in use, the lighthouse serves as a backdrop to the **U.S. Fish and Wildlife Refuge**, where visitors can view various species of seabirds and ocean life, including the Red-footed Booby and the Laysan Albatross, the rare Hawaiian green sea turtle, the Hawaiian monk seal, whales, dolphins and the endangered Nene goose.

**Smith’s Tropical Paradise** has more than 30 acres of lagoons and tropical plants with paths for meandering throughout. **Moir Gardens** surrounds the original plantation manor house, with more than 30 acres of lagoons, lily ponds, flowers and fruit trees. The world’s most famous cactus gardens can be found here, with nearly 4,000 botanical varieties. One of Hawaii’s most highly respected botanical research facilities is **Lawai Gardens**. This 186-acre garden is set in a lush valley and used primarily for educational purposes. It is known worldwide for its rare tropical plants.

Throughout the island you will find great shopping, attractive art galleries, antique stores, kayaking outfitters and surf shops. Wander down the boardwalk along the south shore in **Old Koloa Town** and visit a refurbished sugar mill.

Dining in Kauai will satisfy the most demanding and diverse palates. If tradition

or Hawaiian flair is what you crave, enjoy an authentic feast in the evening, with ancient songs and dance at a **genuine Luau**.

Near **Keahua Arboretum** you can ease into the cool water of the swimming hole, inhale the fragrance of ginger blossoms and savor the sights and sounds of the water and jungle. Numerous trails lead to incredible lookout points on **Mt. Nounou** and on the lower slopes of the **Makelaha Mountains**. **Opaekaa Falls** and **Wialua Falls** are inviting, as are the many waterfalls in the foothills and mountains. A great way to get off the beaten path in Kauai is by paddling a **kayak**. Even novices can safely navigate the island’s rivers to reach secluded waterfalls. Experienced ocean paddlers can explore sections of otherwise inaccessible coastline.

Your vacation does not have to end when the sightseeing is over. Local attractions are great fun as well. Nearby you can find **Lihue Lanes** (a bowling alley), **bass fishing** in a reservoir, local theaters (both live entertainment and movie), the **Allerton Gardens**, **tennis**, **bicycle rentals**, **horseback riding** and many sites for **scuba diving** and **snorkeling**.

Get lost amidst the sparkling-blue waters of the Pacific Ocean, time-etched mountains with tumbling waterfalls, lush greenery, sun-drenched beaches and picture-perfect viewscapes made more beautiful by the people of the island.

## Driving Directions

### From the Lihue Airport

- Immediately upon exiting the airport complex, follow Ahukini Rd to the left.
- In less than 0.25 mile, you will come to a light at a four-way intersection.
- Turn right on Hwy 51, which will become Hwy 56 at the next light.
- Stay on Hwy 56 for 8-miles, following signs through the Wailua area to Kapaa.
- Watch for Safeway on the left. The entrance to the Kapaa Shore Resort is just a little farther, on the right.
