Greetings from Marina, California, on the Monterey Peninsula, home to sunny beaches and exciting attractions like the Monterey Bay Aquarium. Spend your days scuba diving, shopping, lazing by the pool or strolling along the beach at WorldMark Marina Dunes.

This resort consists of 33 two bedroom units, with fully equipped kitchens and small balconies or decks. **None of the units at this resort are air-conditioned** but the close proximity to the ocean rarely results in very high temperatures. **The units are small and, although they can accommodate up to 6 people, having only 4 people will make your stay more comfortable.**

On the Way to Marina Dunes

This section includes points of interest and side trips along the way to the resort. For the most direct route, see "Driving Directions" below.

From the north (scenic)

Go south on US 101...

Eureka is the North Coast's largest city, with nearly 100 restored or preserved **Victorian buildings**, including the **Carson Mansion**, which is the most photographed home in the state. North of Pepperwood, take the turnoff for **Avenue of the Giants**. The road soon becomes enveloped by coastal redwoods, and you will drive through part of **Humboldt Redwoods State Park**. Some of its tallest trees are located in **Founders Grove**.

At the town of Leggett, take Hwy 1 south to Monterey...

Fort Bragg is the headquarters for the famous **Skunk Railroad**, dating back to 1885. Enjoy a scenic half- or full-day tour through redwood forests inaccessible by car.

Since you're going to Monterey Bay, try not to leave your heart in **San Francisco**. Some of the city's highlights include the **Golden Gate Bridge and Park**, **Fisherman's Wharf**, **Alcatraz**, **Union Square**, **Chinatown**, first-class **shopping**, **dining** and **museums**, and of course, a ride on one of the city's storied **cable cars**.

At the beach town of **Santa Cruz**, historic landmarks include the **Boardwalk's** 1911 merry-go-round and Giant Dipper.

From the south (scenic)

Go north on US 101...

The **Santa Barbara County Courthouse** is a magnificent building, completed in 1929. At the top of the courthouse tower you are treated to panoramic views of the city. **Mission Santa Barbara**, **East Beach** and **Sea Center on Stearns Wharf** are other attractions.

At Buellton, take the turnoff for Hwy 246.

For a bit of fun, the Danish town of **Solvang** features Danish architecture and nearly 300 specialty shops.

Take Hwy 1 North to Monterey.

Just slightly north of the college town **San Luis Obispo** is **Morro Rock**. Climb on top and breathe in the ocean air.

The buildings and gardens of the historical **Hearst Castle** are spread over 127 acres. Reservations are a virtual necessity if you want to tour this unfinished work of neoclassical architecture. Call (800) 444-4445.

From the lovely **Bixby Creek Bridge** are views of the California coastline that photographers dream of. Nearby **Point Lobos State Reserve** has rare Monterey

cypress forests, some of the most picturesque stretches of **Big Sur** and 10 miles of hiking trails.

Carmel, though less than one square mile, boasts more than 60 restaurants and 150 boutiques and shops. The village was developed by artists and environmentalists around the turn of the 20th century. With nearly 100 galleries, it is a favorite spot for art lovers today.

Each winter, **Pacific Grove** becomes home to thousands of migrating monarch butterflies. Stately **Victorians** are the other beauties to call the town home. Popular parks are **Lover's Point** and **Asilomar State Beach**.

Situated on hills that slope from beaches to upland pine forests, **Monterey** is tucked in the curve of Monterey Bay. Spend time exploring historic **Cannery Row**, **Fisherman's Wharf** and the **Monterey Bay Aquarium**.

To view the towns of the Monterey Peninsula, mosey along the **17-Mile Drive**. Favorite stops include **Bird Rock**, **Cypress Rock**, the distinctive **Lone Cypress** and **Pebble Beach**.

Driving Directions

From San Francisco, CA:

- Travel south on US-101 to Prunedale.
- Take Hwy-156 W then Hwy-1 S.
- Continue on Hwy-1 to the Reservation Rd exit in Marina.
- At the bottom of the exit, turn right.
- Turn right again on Dunes Rd. The resort is on your left. Follow the brick driveway to the lobby for check-in.

From Los Angeles, CA:

- Drive north on US-101 to Prunedale/Hwy -156 (do not take the Monterey Peninsula exit).
- Follow the **bold** directions above.

From the Monterey Airport:

- Exit the airport on Olmstead Rd heading toward Hwy-68.
- Turn right on Hwy-68. You will be traveling west.
- Hwy-68 merges with Hwy-1 North.
- Continue north on Hwy-1 through Monterey and Seaside.
- Take the second Marina exit, Reservation Rd.



- At the bottom of the exit, turn left on Reservation Rd. Turn right on Dunes Rd. The resort is on your left. Follow our brick driveway to the lobby for check in.
