# Things to See and Do at Oceanside

Oceanside, the northernmost coastal city in San Diego County, is a true beach community offering more than three miles of coastline. This charming town comes complete with an excellent small-craft harbor, sport fishing operations and unique shops and restaurants. Situated in the San Luis Rey Valley, the area's rich history is gracefully preserved in its architecture, as well as its parks and shops.

**Downtown Oceanside** does its best to combine the old with the new. The city's redevelopment project brought life to new restaurants, shops, museums and a 16-screen movie theater—while keeping beautiful old buildings and businesses that have been in operation for more than 50 years.

There are plenty of things to occupy you here. There's the Historic **Oceanside Pier** at the heart of the city's oceanfront activities, and **Heritage Park**, moved in recent years from downtown Oceanside, featuring old-time buildings and special antique collections. And don't forget the **Oceanside Harbor** with 900 plus pleasure and sport-fishing boats, not to mention fine restaurants, picnic tables and **Harbor Village** (with shops, eateries and a lighthouse).

Just beyond town you'll discover the scalloped white adobe of the **Mission San Luis Rey**, founded in 1798. This mission is not only the most sizable of the

California Mission chain, but arguably the most architecturally impressive. In North Oceanside you can visit **Camp Pendleton**, the world's largest U.S. Marine Corps Amphibious Training Base, well recognized for its efforts in preserving ecology and natural resources.

But maybe it's shopping you're looking for—if it is, look no further. A wide variety of malls, boutiques and outlets flood Oceanside: **Plaza Camino Real**, **Fire Mountain Center**, **Camino North Center** and **Pacific Coast Plaza**, to name a few. And for the golfers among you, coastal golf courses such as **El Camino Country Club** and **Emerald Isle Golf Club** capture the beauty and challenge of the valley.

But, just in case you have explored all there is to find within Oceanside itself, venture out to **San Diego**, just 30 miles south of town. San Diego offers, of course, the world-famous **San Diego Zoo**—with everything from giant pandas from China and koalas from Australia to tree kangaroos from New Guinea and pygmy chimpanzees from central Africa. Or, get splashed by a killer whale at **SeaWorld**, take a trolley tour or stop by the **Bazaar Del Mundo in Old Town**.

The historic **San Diego Museum of Art**, located near the zoo in **Balboa Park**, also beckons. This world-class museum is noted for works by old Spanish and Italian

masters, South Asian paintings, 19th- and 20th-century American paintings and sculptures and works by contemporary California artists.

And for you sports fans out there, San Diego is ready and waiting. Professional baseball, football and hockey give you year-round options, while whale watching, golfing, deep-sea fishing, roller-blading, bike riding, surfing and sailing take full advantage of Southern California's incredible climate and setting.

And don't forget **LEGOLAND**, located in Carlsbad, south of Oceanside, which combines 40 hands-on, minds-on, interactive attractions, family rides, shows, restaurants, shopping and landscape features.

Between Oceanside itself and the amazing towns that surround it, you really can't go wrong at WorldMark at Oceanside.

## Driving Directions

### From the north

- Take I-5 South to the Coast Hwy exit in Oceanside.
- Turn right at the end of the off-ramp onto Coast Hwy North.
- Continue over the bridge and turn left onto Monterey Dr.
- Take the next left at the stop sign onto Carmelo Dr.
- Continue to the main entrance of the resort on the right.

### From the south

- Drive I-5 North and take the Coast Hwy exit in Oceanside.
- Turn left at the end of the off-ramp onto Coast Hwy and get in the right lane to follow Coast Hwy North.

- Continue over the bridge and turn left onto Monterey Dr.
- Take the next left at the stop sign onto Carmelo Dr.
- Continue to the main entrance of the resort on the right.

### From the east (Riverside, Las Vegas)

- Take I-15 south to Hwy 76 toward Oceanside.
- Hwy 76 ends at the Coast Hwy, turn right onto Coast Hwy North.
- Continue over the bridge and turn left onto Monterey Dr.
- Take the next left at the stop sign onto Carmelo Dr.
- Continue to the main entrance of the resort on the right.
