Greetings from Pinetop, Arizona, land of the White Mountains and Ponderosa Pines. Spend your day fishing, golfing or hiking. All of this and more awaits you at WorldMark Pinetop.

This resort consists of 61 studio, one, two and three bedroom units with fireplaces and small balconies or decks. **Most units have fully equipped kitchens, but studios come with a 2 burner stove, microwave and small refrigerator.** ResortNet, WorldMark's hi-speed internet service, is available in all units for a small fee.

WorldMark Pinetop is located 7200 feet above sea level, which may require some adjustment for those used to living at lower altitudes. Common amenities include an outdoor pool, outdoor kiddie pool and 2 outdoor uncovered spas. **While the spas are open year round, please note that the pools are closed for winter November 1st to April 1st.** A children's play area and sports court are also available onsite.

On the Way to Pismo Beach

This section includes points of interest and side trips along the way to the resort. For the most direct route, see "Driving Directions" below.

From San Francisco, CA

Head south on Hwy 101...

Discover why **San Francisco** is America's most photographed city and get some great photos of your own. Find hilltop vantage points of the remarkable bridges and beautiful bays. **The much-photographed Golden Gate Bridge** remains an American icon, but some other interesting historical spots include **Ghirardelli Square**, **Alcatraz**, **Fisherman's Wharf**, **Haight-Ashbury** and the old mansions on **Nob Hill**.

Between November and March, stop in **Pacific Grove** to see the migrating **Monarch Butterfly** decorating the town's cypress and oak groves. Pause when you reach **Monterey Bay** to see the peninsula and its famous Spanish architecture. The **Monterey Bay Aquarium** is one of the best in the Western United States.

Carmel is a pleasant stop for dining, shopping, touring galleries or just relaxing. This is a town of ocean beaches and challenging golf courses (it's the home of **Pebble Beach**). Poet Robinson Jeffers built the granite English-style home **Tor House** and **Hawk Tower** in the 1920s, complete with portholes salvaged from

a shipwreck. The **Hearst Castle**, once home to newspaper publisher William Randolph Hearst, is now a State Historical Monument. You can tour its 165 rooms and 127 acres of pools, terraces, gardens and walkways.

You'll come upon **San Luis Obispo** just before reaching Pismo Beach. This town preserves a rich Spanish heritage with its **San Luis de Tolosa Spanish mission** (built in 1772), **Mission Plaza Park** and the local cowboys that live in the outlying ranches. Landmarks here include the scenic **See Canyon Road** and the **Dallidet and Sauer-Adams adobes**. The backdrop of the Santa Lucia Mountains adds to the aura of San Luis Obispo.

From Los Angeles, CA

Drive north on Hwy 101...

Los Angeles is a fun place to begin your vacation. A world of its own, **Disneyland** and its many amusements will make an enjoyable first stop on your itinerary. Don't miss **Hollywood**, with all its glitz and glamour. This community provides unequalled shopping opportunities on **Rodeo Drive**. Visit the **Burbank Studios** and **NBC Studios** to see how Hollywood stars are made. Tour the homes of famous actors, or go where the action is at a local film set. **Six Flags Magic Mountain**,

Universal Studios and **Knotts Berry Farm** are other not-to-be missed stops.

Continue north on Hwy 101...

Mission San Gabriel Arcangel is located just north of Los Angeles. Take a tour of this 1771 Mission and its grounds. Three communities line the San Luis Bay Harbor: **Pismo Beach**, **Shell Beach** and **Avila Beach**. Eye-catching for its white sand beaches, Avila Beach is a lovely stop. Here, walk along any of three fishing piers and watch the sailboats moor. The hills around Avila Beach are home to the **Sycamore Mineral Springs Resort**. Redwood hot tubs dot the hillside in the shade of oak and sycamore trees.

Your destination, Pismo Beach, has more than 23 miles of beautiful beaches as well as the most extensive coastal dunes in California, running from Pismo to the Santa Maria River. At **Pismo Beach State Park**, these rolling, ever-changing hills of sand stretch six miles south to the **Guadalupe Dunes**, providing a unique environment for plants and animals. Fishing for lingcod or red snapper is always an option at the Pismo Beach Pier. The beach also provides opportunities for beachcombers, artists, sunbathers and those who enjoy leisurely walks.

Driving Directions

From the north

- Take Hwy 101 S from San Francisco to the Pismo Beach/Hwy 1 exit.
- At the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Price St.
- Follow Price St through the light at Hinds.
- Travel one block and turn right onto Ocean View Ave.
- **Follow Ocean View three blocks to the beach; the SeaVenture Resort will be on the left. The WorldMark check-in office is inside the SeaVenture Resort lobby.**

From the south

- Take Hwy 101 N from Los Angeles to the Price St exit.
- After the off ramp curves left under the highway, take an immediate left onto Ocean View Ave.
- Follow the **directions in bold** above.
