Reminders

- Units at this urban property are smaller than typical WorldMark units. Cooking and eating space is extremely limited.
- Pets are not allowed on WorldMark resort property.
- There are **NO** parking facilities at the resort. Options include valet parking provided by a local parking service. Rates start at \$29 + tax per day for standard-size vehicles, and \$40 a day + tax for oversize vehicles (e.g. certain SUVs, passenger vans, and trucks) with unlimited in and out privileges. Or you can self-park in the Sutter/Stockton Garage across from the resort. Charges can range up to \$33 per day with no in and out privileges. Larger vehicles or RVs will be considerably more.
- Remember to bring a rain jacket, sunscreen, sunglasses and walking shoes.
- WorldMark provides a smoke-free environment in your units and buildings with a non-smoking policy. Smoking is prohibited.

Things to See and Do in San Francisco

WorldMark San Francisco is ideally located in the heart of the downtown area on the corner of Bush and Stockton Streets. Situated in a historic 1908 building that housed the **Juliana Hotel**, this urban resort is at the crossroads of all that is fun and exciting in the city by the bay. Wear your walking shoes in this town—you can roam easily from one exciting district to the next.

Tour the streets of prestigious **Nob Hill**, home to many well-heeled citizens and the **Fairmont San Francisco**—the first Fairmont hotel—whose lobby served as the primary setting for the 1980s television series *Hotel*. If the worlds of business and finance set your heart fluttering, you're within walking distance of the dynamic **Financial District**, as well as the **Moscone Convention Center**. If shopping is your specialty, a two-block stroll will take you to **Union Square** and a wide range of retail havens: **Prada, Gucci, Armani, Tiffany's, Neiman Marcus, Saks Fifth Avenue, Macy's** and the flagship **Banana Republic** are just a few of the familiar names that will whet your fashion appetite and drain your wallet. Or take a turn directly toward the exotic, because you're just one block from the Dragon Gates of Chinatown and all the

intriguing restaurants and shops contained therein.

The historic **Powell Street Cable Car** is just steps away and runs from **Market Street to Little Italy** in **North Beach** and **Fisherman's Wharf**. At the wharf, feed the seals and grab a plate of just-caught shrimp and a hunk of sourdough bread for the freshest breakfast ever. Or eat dessert first at **Ghirardelli Chocolates**, the famous anchor store of its namesake **Ghirardelli Square**. Either way, you'll be heartily fortified and ready to visit the **Maritime Museum** or tour the **USS Pampanito**, one of the best-restored World War II fleet boats open to the public. If you opt for Little Italy, head to Columbus Avenue for a bevy of taste sensations, including **The Stinking Rose**, whose motto—"We Season Our Garlic With Food!"—tells you everything you need to know about their menu.

For the art lover, the **San Francisco Museum of Modern Art** is a comfortable walk away. And if you're a theater patron, you have your pick of venues: **Nob Hill Masonic Auditorium, Actors' Conservatory Theatre (ACT), Theater on the Square, Curran Theatre, Orpheum Theatre** and **Yerba Buena Center for the Arts** are all close by and offer a great variety

of performing arts attractions.

San Francisco is famous for its landmarks and most are easily accessible from your resort's premier location. The **Coit Tower** at the top of Telegraph Hill offers panoramic views, intriguing murals and a colorful history. For the ultimate San Francisco anti-glamour experience, take a tour of "The Rock"—**Alcatraz**. There are many ticket packages available that include a visit to this notorious site, once considered the toughest prison in the country. And finally, the **Golden Gate Bridge**—arguably the city's most well known signpost—can be traversed via car, bicycle or your own two feet; or viewed from the water by ferry or tour boat.

Driving Directions

From San Francisco Airport (SFO)

- Take US-101 North toward San Francisco.
- Exit onto I-280 North toward the Port of San Francisco.
- Take the Sixth St exit and continue until you get to Taylor St.
- Bear right onto Taylor St.
- Turn right on Bush St.
- WorldMark San Francisco is on the left at the corner of Bush and Stockton St.

From Oakland Airport (OAK)

- Take I-880 North toward downtown Oakland.
- Take the I-80 West exit toward the Bay Bridge/San Francisco.
- Once over the bridge, take the Fremont St exit.

- Turn left on Pine St and drive to Stockton St.
- Turn left onto Stockton. The resort will be on your left on the corner of Stockton and Bush St.

Please note: There are **NO** parking facilities at WorldMark San Francisco. We strongly recommend alternatives such as BART, Amtrak, airport shuttles, taxis or city buses. The nearest BART station is Powell Street, which is five short blocks from the resort.
