



Dear WorldMark Owner/Guest,

Greetings from Lake Tahoe, Nevada, an area made famous by its beautiful lake and heavenly skiing. Spend your days boating, fishing or swimming in the summer or on the slopes skiing or snowboarding in the winter. All of this and more is available during a stay at WorldMark Lake Tahoe.

This resort consists of 50 one, two and three bedroom units located in three separate buildings. **Tahoe I** has six units consisting of two or three bedrooms, all with fully equipped kitchens, washers and dryers, gas fireplaces and whirlpool tubs. **Tahoe II** has six units with two or three bedrooms, all with fully equipped kitchens, washers and dryers and gas fireplaces. **Tahoe III** has 35 one and two bedroom units, with fully equipped kitchens and gas fireplaces. **The Tahoe III units are a bit smaller in size and would be more comfortable with 2 to 4 people, rather than the maximum of 4 to 6. The Tahoe III units also do not have washers and dryers, but there are complimentary laundry facilities available on site. There are no elevators, and stairs are required to reach any unit at this resort.**

The resort is located 7,600 feet above sea level, which may require some adjustment for those used to living at lower altitudes.

WorldMark Lake Tahoe is happy to provide an outdoor pool, an outdoor kiddie pool and an outdoor spa. **Although the spa is open year round, the pools are closed November 1st to April 1st. There is also a community barbecue area that is open June 1st to November 1st.** ResortNet, WorldMark's hi-speed Internet service, is available in all units for a small fee.

On the Way to Lake Tahoe

This section includes points of interest and side trips along the way to the resort. For the most direct route, see "Driving Directions" below.

From Reno, NV

Drive south on Hwy 395 ...

In its heyday during the mid-1900s, the discovery of the Comstock Lode made **Virginia City** "the richest place on earth." Virginia City retains a distinctly western flavor that will transport you back in time. Visitors can walk along its wooden boardwalks, shop for souvenirs and tour the area's mines, museums and restored mansions.

Carson City, Nevada's state capital, offers guided tours of more than a dozen historic homes. Named for the famous scout, the **Kit Carson Trail Walk** will allow you to stretch your legs. The **Nevada State Museum** is also here, one of the 10 best regional museums in the Western United States.

For scenery, nothing beats the 72-mile drive around Lake Tahoe.

Head south again on Hwy 50 ...

Once you've rounded the south end of the lake, you'll spot the glittering playground of **Lake Tahoe**, with its 24-hour casinos. **Harveys**, **Harrah's**, the **Lakeside Inn** and the **Horizon** are just some of the hot spots. Top-name entertainers appear in the showrooms and cabarets, while chefs work their magic at the many restaurants. For a fascinating glimpse into Tahoe's history, visit the 74-acre **Tallac Historical Site**. The **Tallac Museum** features the 19th-century gaming world of Elias J. "Lucky" Baldwin. The **Lake Tahoe Visitors Center** is also located here.

From Sacramento, CA

Drive north on Hwy 50 to Lake Tahoe, then go east, still on Hwy 50...

On your way to Tahoe, take a breather in **Placerville**, once a rip-roaring mining camp known as Hangtown for its frontier-style justice. Today, Placerville has the distinction of being one of the only cities in the world to own a gold mine. The **Gold Bug Mine**, with a fully-lighted shaft, is

open for touring.

Lake Tahoe is one of the most photographed lakes in the world, and is the largest alpine lake in North America. A scenic 72-mile driving tour around the lake will allow you to discover the best vantage points and popular beaches. Once you hit South Lake Tahoe, you'll find plenty of shopping. Satisfy your urge to browse and take advantage of great deals at numerous boutiques, specialty shops, casino shops and manufacturer outlet stores.

If you need money to support your shopping habit, the 24-hour **casinos** hug the shore, giving you plenty of opportunities to gamble.

Emerald Bay State Park, on the southwest side of the lake, offers spectacular views of the mountains, the lake, **Fannette Island** and **Vikingsholm Castle**. Built by wealthy heiress Lora Knight in 1929, Vikingsholm is a 38-room Scandinavian stone castle, patterned after an 800 A.D. Norse fortress.

Driving Directions

From Sacramento, CA:

- Take Hwy-50 into South Lake Tahoe, turn east and travel through the town.
- Go across Stateline through the casino area. Continue past the casinos to the second traffic light.
- At Hwy-207, Kingsbury Grade, turn right up the hill.
- **Continue until you reach the summit, then turn right on Tramway Dr.**
- **The resort is on the right and the sign reads WorldMark, 202 Tramway.**
- **Turn into the driveway and head to the top of the hill. The registration office is in Building D.**

From Reno, NV:

- Take US-395 South through Carson City.
- At the south end of town, turn right on Hwy-50 West, Lake Tahoe. This will take you to the southeast end of the lake.
- As you are approaching the casino area, you will see Kingsbury Grade/Hwy-207.
- Turn left and follow the directions in **bold**.

From Southern California:

- Take US-395 North through the towns of Gardnerville and Minden.
- At the north end of Minden, take a left at the last traffic light at Route-88 (at the Lake Tahoe sign). Follow the signs to Lake

Tahoe/Kingsbury Grade.

- Take Kingsbury Grade/Hwy-207 to the top of the mountain. Tramway Dr is a left turn at the summit.
- Follow the directions in **bold** to the left.
