2010 Winter Olympics Special Reservation Policy

Adopted by the WorldMark Board: September 29, 2008

PURPOSE

This special event booking policy has been adopted to allow the greatest number of owners the opportunity to enjoy this once in a lifetime event.

Dates and Resorts Affected

Reservation Restrictions

Maximum length of Reservation	Any reservation which includes a night between February 12 and February 28, 2010 in any of the affected resorts is subject to a maximum 16 night reservation restriction. This will allow an Owner to enjoy the entire Olympic experience if so desired.
Number of Units Allowed	There will be a maximum of two units that any "Owner" (not account, but Owner) can reserve that includes a night at affected resorts. (Note: Maximum 16 night booking still applies in that if two units are reserved - the maximum reservation can be for any combination of nights per unit as long as the two reservations do not exceed two units and 16 nights.)
Grouped Reservations	Grouped Reservations are allowed into the affected resorts, however, the segments in resorts outside of the affected resorts, count toward the 16 night maximum stay. If one segment of a grouped reservation is cancelled, all segments must be cancelled and are subject to the 48 hour wait before rebooking.
On Line Bookings	Online booking will be disabled at the affected resorts beginning December 25, 2008. Affected resorts will remain unavailable for online booking until they are completely booked for the affected dates listed. Note: Disconnecting a resort from online booking cannot be set for a specific time period. The affected resorts will not be able to be booked online for any future dates until the online booking is enabled. Once the affected resorts are completely reserved for the affected dates they will be enabled for online booking.
Restriction Application	These restrictions will be applied " per Owner " regardless of the number of accounts owned or number of names on account.
Owner Communication	This policy for booking during the Olympics will be communicated in Destinations and online at www.worldmarktheclub.com . Q & A's will be provided to help owners understand the policy and advise that any reservation found out of compliance will need to be rebooked to fall into compliance or be cancelled.
